JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION:

STUDENT MINISTRIES WORSHIP INTERN

PRIMARY FUNCTION:

Under the leadership of the Pastor of Students and Children and the Director of Middle School Ministries the Student Ministries Intern will be a vital part of the Student Ministries Team. The responsibilities of the intern will be varied but they will have specific duties in the area of worship for students.

PRIMARY DUTIES:

Ministry Responsibilities:

1. To work with the Pastor of Students and Children and the Director of Middle School Ministries to develop a vision and strategy for worship in Student Ministries
2. Build relationships with students through regular contact
3. Build relationships with volunteer team for Student Ministries
4. To lead, equip, encourage and develop the Student Worship Band both musically and in their relationship with God
5. To be an upfront presence during our Sunday Morning program (Noise) and other activities
6. Bring creative worship elements to Noise and other special events
7. Be current in worship songs and trends
8. Be involved in planning and implementation of our Sunday Morning program (Noise) and other special events
9. Teach Sunday Morning lessons for both Middle School and Senior High on occasion
10. Other duties as assigned by the Pastor of Students and Children and the Director of Middle School Ministries

- Saturday Worship Band Rehearsals
- Sunday Morning Worship
- Sunday Morning Student Worship
- Special Events
- Wednesday and Thursday Night Programs on occasion
- One year internship

- Ideally, this individual has talents singing, playing an instrument, and leading worship for students and building a worship team of students
- Proven leadership and management skills
- Possesses strong servant leadership, relational, discipleship and administrative skills

- Eagerness to lead and be self-motivated in planning, creating and implementing programs
