The **Journey to Mosaic** is a four-day experiential ethnic immersion bus trip exploring challenges of our multi-ethnic society from Northern California to Southern California. The goal is to provide a safe time and place for the church to talk about race realities in America that affect how we live and minister. It unpacks portions of the African American, Asian American, and Hispanic American stories in California through tours, videos, and partner/large group discussions. Participants engage the time with a partner from a different ethnic background. By its very nature, the journey is both eye-opening and stretching. In addition to consciousness raising, the trip invites participants to grow in understanding and love of one another.*
